New Officer Induction took place at last month's meeting, May 2, 2017.

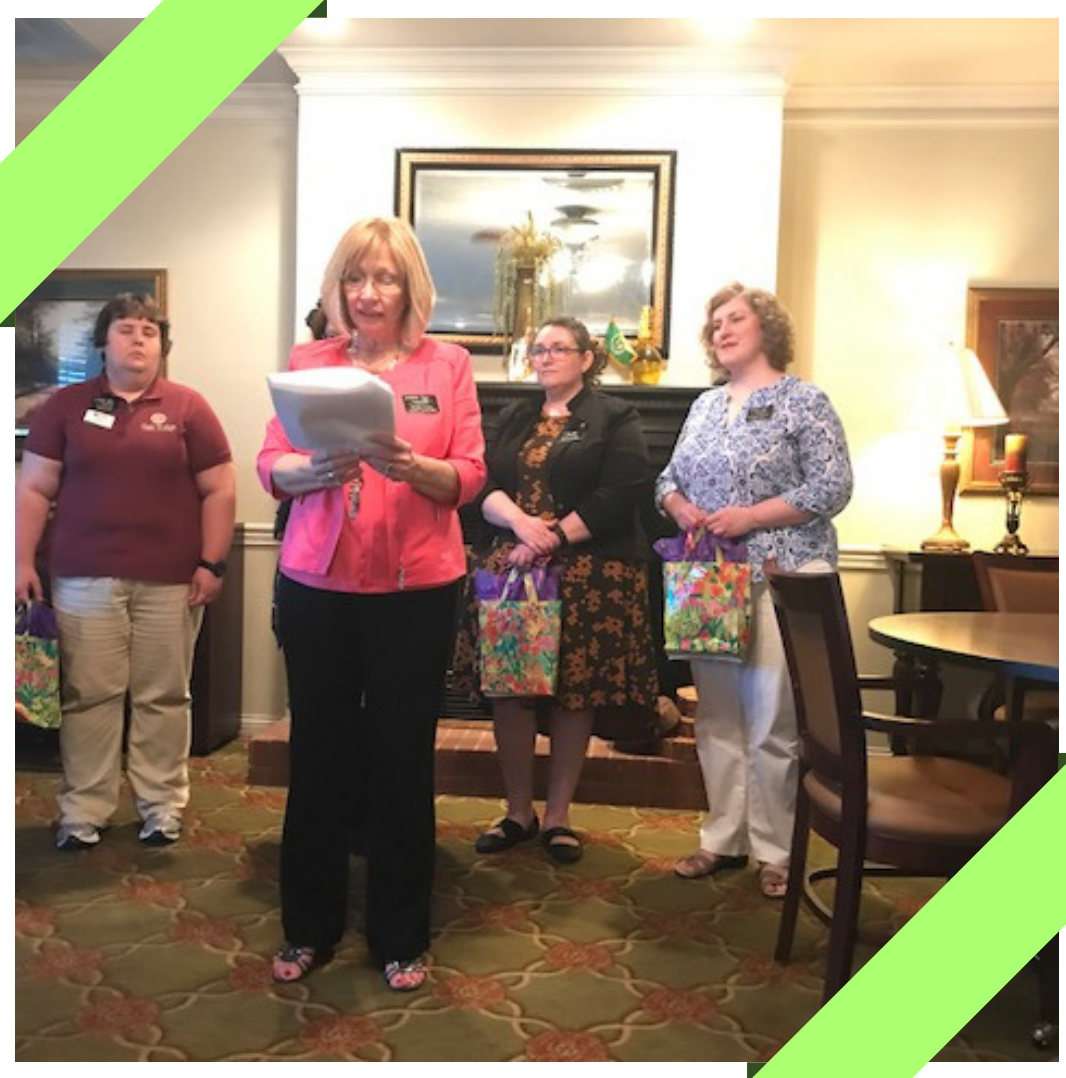
