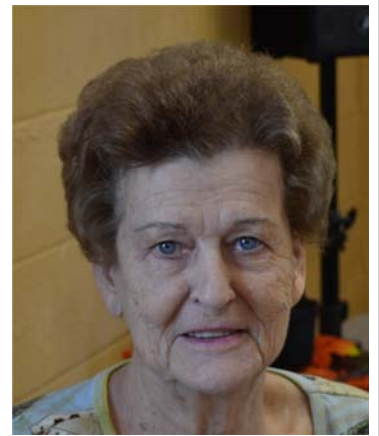

Ms. Jean joined Hopkinsville BPW in July 1975.



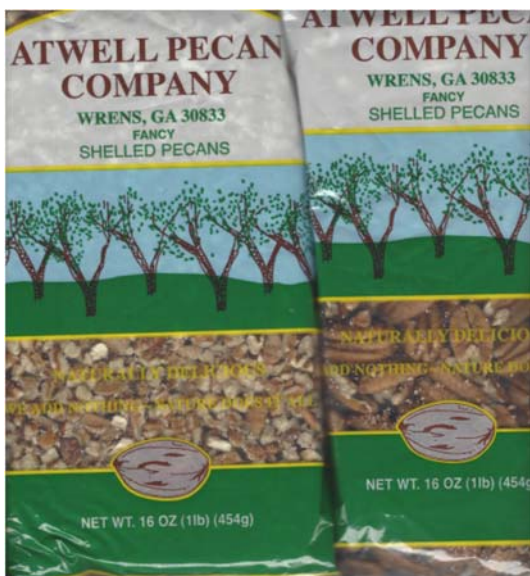
