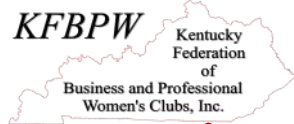

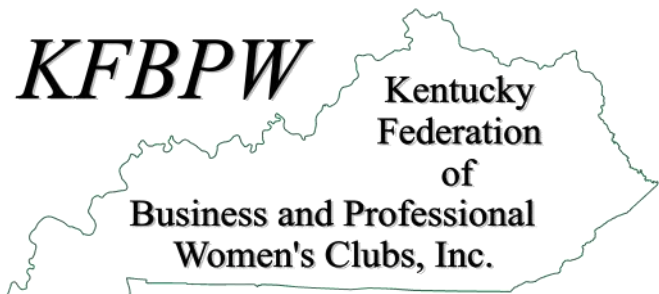
Kathy Beasecker
