TREASURER

2017-2018 LOCAL ASSESSMENTS ARE DUE

INSURANCE: \$75

The Executive Committee accepted a bid through McElroy, Wharton & Boldrick, Inc. for two Insurance Policies. One is our Directors and Officers Insurance with Old Republic and the second is General Liability Insurance with a Treasurers Bond through Westfield. Both policies are for the fiscal year 2017-2018 and cover the State, Regions and Locals; however, Locals are not covered in the Treasurers Bond. Also, **special events are not covered** in these policies and must be obtained by the Local as a one-time policy per event (special events, such as a carnival, raising money, selling alcohol, wine tasting).

The total cost of insurance is \$2,114.72 split between the Directors and Officers at \$1,051.23 and the General Liability at \$1,063.49. Each LO is assessed \$75 per year by the KFBPW to cover part of this expense or \$1,275 of the total \$2,114.72 cost.

Local Assessments are due July 1 of each year. If you have not yet paid, make your check payable to KFBPW and mail to Ginny White-Schatzke, KFBPW Treasurer, at the address below.

STATE CONFERENCE DUES: \$10

According to Article VII, Section 4 of the Kentucky Federation Bylaws, each Local Organization shall pay annual state conference dues of \$10 and should remit them to the Kentucky Federation of Business and Professional Women's Clubs, Inc. postmarked on or before July 31st of each year. Make your check payable to KFBPW and mail to Ginny White Schatzke, KFBPW Treasurer at the address below.

Get Stepping BPW



The goal of this challenge is to walk as many steps from August 1, 2017 - May 15, 2018. This will be a club challenge and the winner will be decided based on the team's average number of steps. For example: if a local has 10 walkers, you will add all 10 tracking sheets and divide by 10 and give the average for team.

Each member will keep up with their steps and turn in totals to your local president. Copies of your step sheet will be submitted to the Local President on October 1, 2017 and May 15, 2018 for submission to the State President for validation within the week. The local that averages the most steps will be recognized at the Interim Board meeting and State Conference.

You might asked the question, "What's in it for me?"

- ◆ Improve your health
- ◆ Improve mobility
- ◆ Help you to lose weight
- ◆ Have time to walk with a friend or family member
- ◆ The cardiovascular benefit of walking are biologically plausible; like other forms of regular moderate exercise, walking improves cardiac risk factors such as cholesterol, blood pressure, diabetes, obesity, vascular stiffness, and inflammation, and mental stress.
- ◆ Long, peaceful walks calm you down, pace your thoughts, and clear your head.

Are you an exercise loner?

- Take your dog for a walk
- Walk to the store if it is within reasonable distance.
- Choose the stairs instead of the elevator.
- Park further away from the store entrance.

Enjoy exercising with others?

- Walk with a coworker at lunch.
- Take a walk with family after dinner.
- Walk to a co-worker's desk instead of calling him/her.
- Walk around the mall.
- Join club members for a group walk!

Additional ways to get active

- Walk when you talk on the phone.
- Have walking meetings with coworkers.
- When watching TV, run in place during commercials.
- Start a walking club with your KFBPW members.

One mile of walking equals about 2,000 steps depending on your stride and how fast you walk.
