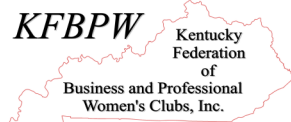

BYLAWS ARE YOUR FRIEND.

Roberts Rules of Order indicate that the **Bylaws are the most important document** of an organization. **BUT WHY?**

Very Simply, the bylaws document explains the structure of the organization, i.e., when the organization meets; what type meeting is required (local or state, interim or full board); who presides during the meeting; when nomination and election of officers is scheduled; eligibility for office; the dues structure; “who is in good standing”; and when an annual meeting is required, just to name a few items.
